From the Secretary Desk:

The Fourth Annual General Body Meeting of the Old Students' Association of Govt. Mohindra College, Patiala, was held in the college Sabha Bhavan on 3rd June '89. Dr. B. C. Gupta, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Patiala, was the chief guest.

Speaking on the occasion, Dr. Gupta made a plea for bridging communication gaps and for making optimum utilization of the infra structural facilities available at Patiala. He touched upon the Multipurpose Gymnasium to be built at a cost of Rs. 1.50 crore for meeting the needs of indoor sports events of the town. He also referred to the proposed Railway Overbridge at Railway Phatak No. 17, near the bus stand. This, he said, will be the only bridge to be built in the state in the near future. He assured the members of a sympathetic consideration of all the proposals made in the meeting in connection with the development and special status of this premier college of the state.

Earlier, Dr. Joginder Singh, Officiating President of the Association, welcomed the chief guest and delegates to the meeting and appealed for strengthening the base of the Association so that it might be able to serve the interest of the institution in an effective manner.

Prof. M. S. Salh. Secretary of the Association, in his report stressed the need for renaming the Lower Mall as Mohindra College Road and wanted it to be closed for heavy vehicles, in the academic interest of the institution. He also made a plea for a special grant for the maintenance of this more-than-a-century old college. He declared that a Directory of 500 well placed and distinguished Mahendrians would be brought out in the coming year.

Others who participated in the deliberations included Shri G. S. Grewal, Additional Deputy Commissioner, Sangrur, Dr. Bhagat Singh, Retd. V C. Shri Harpal Tiwana, Shri Brij Lal Goel, Ex. MLA, Prof. Gursewak Singh, Brig Sukhdev Singh, Dr. Partap Singh, Principal O P. Vijh, Shri Bal Krishan Singla, Dr. Mohinder Singh Chugh, Prof. H. S. Sekhon, Prof. S. C. Sharma and Dr. Yogendra Bakhshi.

A brief cultural programme was also presented on this occasion and a memento was presented to Mr. Vijay Gurdaspuri for his Punjabi songs.
