Health Care Symposium and Camp



Born on 3rd March 1929 Dr. Joginder Singh, Founder Patron of the Association and former Principal of Mohindra College, is an energetic and dynamic person. He did his Ph.D on the 'Critical Study

of Commentaries in Japuji' from Punjab University, Chandigarh in 1975. He has twelve books and thirty research articles to his credit.

He remained a member of the Syndicate and Senate, the Academic Council, the Sports Executive and various other bodies of Punjabi University and Punjab University from 1977 to 1987. He was invited to present a paper at an International Conference entitled 'Imperatives of Co-operation between Afro-Asian countries held in New Delhi in 1986. He is also periodically invited to participate in various literary & religious programmes telecast by Doordarshan and broadcast by A.I.R. He was nominated by the Punjab Government to the Advisory Board of Guru Nanak Foundation, New Delhi, for five years.

Dr. Joginder Singh also worked as commanding officer of an NCC Battalion while on deputation with the Ministry of Defence, Government of India. He topped in the All India Refresher Course of NCC Officers at Poona in 1969 and got an outstanding grade. These days, he is the President of the Old Students' Association of Mohindra College.

He was elected President of Punjab Govt. College Lecturers' Association in 1978 and had four terms of office. He was Vice-President PFUCTO and a member of the Executive of AIFUCTO. He was elected Secretary of Old Students' Association in May 1986 and is now serving as General Secretary.

He remained Warden of the College Hostel; Dean Students' Welfare of the college; member of Board of Postgraduate studies, and Faculty of Social Sciences of Pbi. University, Patiala and member of Punjab School Education Board.

Prof. P.S. Sidhu : A Profile

Prof. P.S. Sidhu is a living legend of the college. As a matter of fact, nature has conferred on Prof. Sidhu the rare distinction of having the longest association with the



college; first, as a student, then as a teacher; and finally, as an administrator for three brief periods, the last of which is the most memorable. Fair and friendly to all, Prof. Sidhu exudes warmth and affection and is the cynosure of every body's attention. As a gifted conversationalist, he generates guffaws of laughter when he is surrounded by his select coterie of friends.

Born on 16th February, 1941 in the erstwhile princely state of Patiala, Parminder Singh Sidhu S/o S. Gurbhagat Singh, Under Secretary PPSC, had his education at Khalsa School and Mohindra College respectively. He did his postgraduation in English from Punjabi University, Patiala, in 1963.

He made his debut as a teacher way back in 1963. Interestingly enough, he joined the Punjab Education Department in the women's cadre and served at Govt. College for Girls, Govt. Bikram College of Commerce and Govt. Mohindra College, Patiala, for well over three decades.

Then in 1994 this doyen of English blossomed into a Principal and started his administrative career at Govt. College, Fazilka. Shortly afterwards he came nearer home to Govt. College, Dera Bassi, as a scintillating successor to esteemed Prof. Kashmir Singh Gill who had been elevated to the rank of D.P.I. (C) Punjab. Prof. Sidhu took over as Principal of this college for the third and final time in 1998. He deserves kudos for building a new Biology Lab and a girls' common room in a record time.

Prof. Sidhu has been associated with various bodies of the University, including the

Faculty of Commerce, the Faculty of Languages, the Advisory Committee for Youth Welfare Department, and the Selection Committee for Teachers and Principals.

He is happily married to Mrs. Kawaljit Sidhu, the gracious First Lady of the College who provides him ceaseless psychological support and spiritual strength to attain ever higher pinnacles of glory.
